

## 2023-24 NEGFL MEETING

1. Coaches meeting-ALL Documents and fees to be turned in October 22<sup>nd</sup> @ Athens Sports Arena meeting at 4:00 pm  
**No games can be played with any player who hasn't turned in the proper paperwork or any team who hasn't paid their registration fee.**
2. Registration fee(s) \$1000 can be check, cash or Vemno Michael-Palmer-125
3. Schedule-Weekends played November 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup>, November 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup>, November 18<sup>th</sup>/19<sup>th</sup>, December 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup>, December 9<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup>, December 16<sup>th</sup>/17<sup>th</sup>, January 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup>, January 13<sup>th</sup>/14<sup>th</sup>, January 20<sup>th</sup>/21<sup>st</sup>, January 26<sup>th</sup>/27<sup>th</sup>, Playoffs start on Sunday, January 28<sup>th</sup> through February 5<sup>th</sup>.
4. Admission fee-\$5 and \$3
5. GHSA Rules except where governing rules prevail-**One new GHSA rule change for this year is no more 1 and 1, you will shoot 2 free throws on the 5<sup>th</sup> foul.**
6. Ball size for every division:  
28.5 4th through 7th grade  
27.5 3rd Grade Division (2nd/3rd) 8 ½ foot goal
7. The maximum number of coaches on the team bench will be two (2).  
3<sup>rd</sup> (4) 8-minute running clock quarters  
4<sup>th</sup> (4) 10-minute running clock quarters  
5<sup>th</sup> Grade – (4) 10-minute running clock quarters  
6<sup>th</sup> Grade – (4) 10-minute running clock quarters  
7<sup>th</sup> Grade – (4) 10-minute running clock quarters
8. Press – No full court press allowed after 12-point lead. One warning, then a technical on the Coach will be assessed.
9. Press – No full court press allowed in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade division.
10. Regular Season Standings will be used to determine the tournament seeding.
11. In addition to the stated purposes of the Code of Conduct of the NEGFL, it will be strictly against the policy of the NEGFL for any person either as player, spectator, or coach to:
  - a. Engage in arguments or unprivileged touching of an official, coach, participant, or NEGFL representative;
  - b. To use abusive or foul language;
  - c. To harass officials; and
12. Coaches are also responsible for reviewing and enforcing this Code of Conduct with their players and parents.
13. If a coach or player receives either 2 technical fouls, a flagrant foul or is ejected from a game, they will be suspended for at least one game thereafter.
