- I will adhere to and require compliance with measures to maintain an environment free of drugs, alcohol and tobacco use.
- I will be a positive role model and will ask my players to treat other players, coaches, fans and referees with respect.
- I will remember that the game is for youth – not for adults.
- I will, under no circumstances, have any physical contact with a player, coach, fan or referee during a confrontational situation.
- I will not engage in arguments, use foul or abusive language, or exhibit any acts of verbal or physical aggression.
- Although Coaches cannot be responsible for the conduct of other adults, I will take the appropriate actions to intervene and counsel parents/fans of my team whenever necessary.
- I take responsibility for explaining to my players Parents' that violations of the Code of Conduct may be subject them to removal or ejection by the NEGFL at any facility holding a competition.
